A rtist Shukla Chowdhury's acrylic canvas paintings are on display at the Habitat Centre this week. The exhibition, called *Phoenix Sings a Song*, has a collection of 28 works. These range from hold stroke paintings to wash canvases. Shukla Chowdhury's paintings draw their inspiration from the phoenix, the mythical bird and its journey of life and re-birth.
